Randy Pamperien called the meeting to order at 10:00 AM. An introduction of guests and members were made at this time.

Motion to approve the December 20, 2022 minutes was made by Scott Long and seconded by David Trotter. All were in favor. Motion carried.

New Business

Southeast District Projects and Happenings – MoDOT Reps.

Chris Rutledge said work is starting in work zones and bridges. Factors such as inflation, availability of materials and the shrunken workforce have all contributed to work being slowed. Things that are being worked on now are a reflection of TAC efforts from years back. Work on 95 is occurring as well as overlay and taking care of the existing system. He added that the work of the TAC is important, and if there are any questions, please let him know.

Michael said that the letting on the roundabout in Douglas County will start Friday. He added that asphalt has gone up over 50%, and the STIP is still in draft mode. We were not able to add anything from the unfunded needs list or any overlays or bridge replacements. Tier I has been wiped out. As soon as the draft STIP is done, they would start the unfunded needs list.

Chris said that projects may be delayed due to inflation and delayed funding. The governor has submitted a budget proposal, and some general revenue is going toward I-70. There is also legislation regarding the highway commission having appropriation authority. If there are any updates when voting, please ask. He added that inflation has been much greater than the gas tax increase.

Update Regional List

Trent said that updates were just completed on the regional list last August. He said that if there are any changes or projects to add, please do so. This list is due to MoDOT the first part of May. The goal today is to update the list. First the group will get together with their respective counties. Trent then explained the voting process for members.

Per Brad Loveless, David Norman will be voting in place of Travis Cheyney today. (per bylaws Article 4, Section 4.6).

Trent said that there needs to be a representative from each county to present their most important project. The TAC representatives then went county by county and presented those. Stickers were also placed on other county projects by members from outside those counties. Trent said the results will be tallied and sent to the group, then on to MoDOT.
