**Southeast District Projects and Happenings – MoDOT Reps.**

Joe distributed a handout that covers past lettings, work zone updates, and the cost-share program.

Elquin discussed the resurfacing work around Thayer. She also said that in regard to the TAP funds, all projects that were submitted were taken. Ava and Mansfield were awarded in the SCOCOG area.
