Revising of TAC Priority List

Cody said that two potential funding sources were identified and discussed at the last TAC meeting; the Governor’s Bridge Program, and the Amendment Three Program (Additional Bonding Capacity). The TAC has been tasked with coming up with a project list. Some costs were off from the last meeting on both lists, so a new list needs to be built today. The group discussed priorities and made modifications to the existing list. The new project priority lists are as follows in order of priority on each table:

Install a J-Turn at Route 99 and US 60 in Birch Tree. Install flashing speed check signage on eastbound US 60 coming into Birch Tree. Install additional flashers and signage at the 19 and US 60 intersections in Winona.	1,579,000
Expand Route 17/CC (Gibson Ave) in West Plains to five lanes from US63 to Bus. 63	2,731,000
Construct a proper roundabout at Bus. Route 5 and North Jefferson Ave. in Ava	1,100,000
Install traffic signal at the MO 5 and Route Y intersection in Ava	465,000
Center turn lane on Route 181 from US 60 to Main Street in Cabool	558,000

PROJECT	MAGNITUDE OF DOLLARS
Expand Route 95 in Mtn. Grove to provide three lanes from Red Spring Rd. to Bus. 60	7,989,000
Expand US 63 to four lanes from Bill Virdon Blvd. in West Plains to Route PP	10,800,000
Intersection improvements (roundabout) to alleviate traffic congestion at Howell Avenue and Business 63 in West Plains	1,200,000
Install a right turn lane from southbound Route BB onto US 160 in West Plains	357,000
Implement flood mitigation measures on MO 142 east of the Eleven Point River bridge in Oregon County	3,300,000
Pave existing 4' aggregate shoulders along MO 5 from Route A to Gainesville in Douglas and Ozark Counties	6,500,000
Resurface and install safety shoulders & guardrail on MO 14 from Route O to Beaver Creek Bridge in Douglas County	850,000

Expand US 63 to four lanes from Route PP, south toward the state line as far as the funding allows.	11,180,000

It was also discussed to take all projects off the Amendment Three list and the Additional 30% list and use funds (approximately \$33,000,000) to 4-lane US Highway 63, and construct the Mountain Grove project (approximately \$8,000,000). The projects currently on the list would get pushed back into the “planning process.” The group, however, did not decide on this course of action at this time, and agreed upon the project table above.
